



STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Submission of a Course Application indicates a firm commitment and intention to attend a course.
2. All fees are due and payable before the first day of training.
3. After submitting a Course Application, delegates may still cancel without penalty, providing that the cancellation is received in writing no less than 10 working days before the course start date.
4. Cancellation of a booking less than 10 working days before start of a course will incur a cancellation fee of 25% of the course fee.
5. No credit or refund of fees will be given where a delegate fails to arrive for a course or withdraws from a course which has already started, except in exceptional circumstances and at the sole discretion of MBAT.
6. Delegates whose payment is not received by confirmation due date may, at MBAT's discretion, be replaced by delegates who have paid.
7. Substitution of one delegate for another is permissible and will not incur cancellation fees.
8. MBAT reserves the right to exclude delegates from a course or withhold results from a course where course fees have not been settled in full.
9. MBAT regrettably reserves the right to cancel or postpone courses where insufficient demand for the course would make it financially unviable, or where low student numbers would hamper the learning experience.
10. MBAT reserves the right to make, without prior notification, changes to course structure and material, where this will result in a more effective learning experience.
11. All dates remain provisional until the course starts, and in some instances may be subject to change as customers, force majeure and market forces required.
12. Any price quoted is only valid for 30 days from date of transmission.
13. Quoted course prices are based on a delegate completing the standard programme within the allotted times. Supplementary Fees will apply where a delegate is unable to complete the course within the prescribed schedule, for example when a transfer to another course is permitted, supplementary exams are written, or assignments are resubmitted. 14. No relaxation or indulgence granted by MBAT on these terms and conditions shall in any way constitute a waiver of any the rights and shall not preclude MBAT from exercising any rights which may have arisen in the past or which might arise in the future.
